**Heritage Hall+Kitchen+Lower Hall Updates** - I would like to take this opportunity on behalf of the UCW as well as the whole church to thank all those involved in the refurbishment that has been taking place for several weeks now in the Heritage Hall, Kitchen and Lower Hall. Many people have been involved in this project, which started off as a HH kitchen rebuild with leadership, planning and 75 % of the funds from the UCW and the remaining from SUC funds.

In the process of working on the kitchen, it became quite evident that the whole Heritage Hall needed repainting and so a group of 10 members of the congregation had a marathon painting week for this 40ft X 60 ft Hall. What a difference this has made in updating and freshening up this whole space! We are so thankful to Adelaide who took this a step further over the past 2 weeks by repainting the accompanying hall and bathrooms.

The installation of the kitchen countertops is expected to happen during the second week of April and we hope to be ready for an opening celebration with the UCW sponsored Spring Pot Luck Dinner to be held on Thursday, April 19th. More details will be forthcoming regarding this Dinner.
