This Committee is responsible for the safety and security of the Church Home; maintenance of its building, grounds and furnishings; supervision of major replacement, repair and improvement projects; and managing the rental of the church facilities.

The chair should have a good knowledge of commercial building structure and infrastructure, materials and supplies, as well as experience with contractors and some renovation work. In addition, an awareness of skills and building knowledge by congregational members is helpful.

Responsibilities include:

- Available 24 hours/7 days of the week for emergency repair issues.
- Prepares property project budget
- Prioritize and schedules project activities
- Reports on all repair and project issues to the Church Council on a monthly basis
- Responds to committee requests on building repair issues and improvement needs.
- Reviews contracted scope of works and renewals of annual contracts
- Analyze of property expenses for on-going cost and efficiency improvements.
- Liaise with the financial committee on property spend rate.
- Attend and report at monthly Church council meetings.
- Summarize property activities for Annual Report
