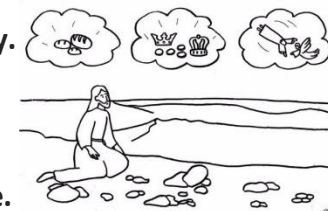

Syrian Refugee Request - Tarek Youzbashi, the single man originally from Syria that we sponsored to Canada, is still seeking employment in his field of expertise. Tarek recognized shortly after arriving in Canada at the end of May last year, that his area of expertise, English-Arabic translation, interpretation, and editing is a very specialized one and that it may take time to find employment in that field. Tarek has thus been very diligent about expanding his skillsets into other areas where he could build on his expertise. Recently he completed certification at the University of Toronto Faculty of Social Work as a community liaison worker. This effectively qualifies Tarek to work for settlement agencies and other community organizations that offer one on one assistance to refugees and other Arabic/English speaking people. Concurrently Tarek applied, and obtained the necessary Canadian certifications for his Master’s Degree from Egypt and is currently awaiting his certification by CTTIC, (Canadian Translators Terminologists and Interpreters Council). Additionally Tarek has been volunteering two to three days each week at the United Church of Canada SAH (refugee) office and S.E.A.S. Centre (Support Enhance Access Service Centre) where his skills have been put to very good use. He has been a busy guy!
