



<u>Sign-up for Summer Help!!</u> Although Sunday School will close for the summer, we are eager to provide child-care and student support during July and August. CPR and AED Course Interest

One of the time and talent ideas was to have a CPR and AED course. It has been quite a while since we got the defibrillator, and I saw a need for training in addition to moving it to a more accessible location at SUC. Ontario Health at Home offers a great program that would fulfill this need.

What we need to know is who is interested in which format and when from the congregation and community around us. Registration with payment must be made at least a month in advance. They offer evenings, Saturday and Sunday. If full day, they can do 2 evenings.

There must be a **minimum of 10 people** to have this event on site.

The **cost per person is \$99 plus HST for half day** and **\$159 plus HST for full day.** Suggest there are three courses available to use:

- (1) a full day CPR and AED no reading
- (2) half day e-book in advance of course CPR and AED
- (3) full day first aid, CPR and AED with e-book.

I will have a signup sheet in the Narthex until June 15, or you can contact me at marthaheeney7@gmail.com. We are planning on mid to late September and once we get interest and timing hope to book by end of June. Payment will be collected as your commitment to the course once we finalize date and program.

<u>Courtyard Upgrading Project</u> - This will start on Monday June 2nd, and is expected to last about 2 weeks. The interlocking stone will be replaced. Playground mulch will be installed in the Montessori play area. Sod will be installed in the area next to the office at the end of the summer. Access to the church from the parking lot will be restricted for the next two weeks to the door at the elevator entrance. Thank you to UCW and Willowtree Montessori School for generously financing most of this project.
